



Updates On the Ganaraska Forest Closure

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, December 16, 2022 (Port Hope, ON) – Winter Trails in the Ganaraska Forest are getting ready to welcome visitors in mid-to-late January 2023.

GRCA staff, partners and contractors have been working hard to recover the cross-county ski and snowshoe trails from the devastating storm in May 2022.

Over the past two weeks, the final, big trail blockages were removed on the ski and snowshoe trails, in the Central Forest.

However, the opening will be delayed to ensure active harvest operations, associated with tree thinning, in and around the ski and snowshoes trails, are complete and trail users remain safe from mechanical operations.

Staff are anticipating a mid-to-late January 2023 opening of cross country and snowshoe trails as a result. The Blue Trail will remain closed for the 2023 Winter Season, due to operational needs.

The OFSC designated trails are not impacted by this opening delay. Please visit ofsc.on.ca to learn about trail conditions in the region.
